### Annual Dues

The annual dues for 2026 is \$500 plus any applicable dock or mooring fees. Dock fees will remain at \$500 and Mooring fees will remain at \$200 for 2026. Payment of all balances is due within 60 days of receiving the invoice. As requested at last year's annual meeting, we have been working on a method to send out invoices via email and accept online payments. We have not been able to work out all the bugs as yet so for this year we are reverting to the tried and true method of sending invoices via regular mail and receiving payment via mailed check. We'll keep working with the goal to have online options available to members by next year.

This year there will also be a one time assessment fee of \$350 to help cover maintenance and upkeep of association facilities and amenities. If the one time assessment creates a financial burden, members are encouraged to reach out to the Board at [wphlongisland@gmail.com](mailto:wphlongisland@gmail.com) to discuss payment arrangements. However, the full assessment must be paid no later than the end of our fiscal year on July 31, 2026. Special Note: As a matter of fairness to all members who make timely payments, the Board must enforce the long established 10% late fee for payments received after the 60 day payment period.
