West Point Association Trash Notice

Please Note: The Board of Directors feels that this is an important and appreciated service for our members. Please take these guidelines under consideration when dumping trash and please share with all visitors and rental guests you may have.

Absolutely **HOUSEHOLD TRASH ONLY!!!!** (This means no old gas grills, old mattresses, building materials, brush, etc. These types of materials must be taken to the dump.)

<u>PLEASE</u> breakdown cardboard boxes and crush plastic milk, water and soda bottles to more efficiently use the dumpster space especially during the summer months

During the summer months there are 2 pick-ups per week. There is one pick-up during the winter. Summer pick-ups are normally on Tuesday and Friday. Winter pick-ups are on Friday.

Please make sure that you open the side doors and put the trash towards the back.

Do not throw trash on the top or leave it on the ground. This brings animals and crows and the results are trash all over the ground. If the dumpster is full take your trash home or keep until mid-week.

Non-members using the dumpster should be asked their name and where they live. All members need to be aware and speak up if you think someone is not a member and is using the dumpster. If you notice use from non-members, take the license plate number and call the police. They are aware that it is for West Point members only.
