Al, John, Sandy, Ashly, Tom, Lou present – Zoom – Bruce, Tim, Shawna

Shawna moved to & Tom-waived motioned to go over reading of the minutes from last Board meeting; Seconded by TomAssociation meeting in August 2021

Bruce - Budget for Fiscal Year 2022 adjustments

Shawna and Tom will work together on the drainage on the beach – will get an estimate to complete work. Tom would like to try and manage the labor work in house versus virus paying for labor to the extent possible.

Discussed leaving Kayaks after Columbus Day for folks that use them until snow falls.

<u>Shawna advises that</u> Tuesday, Oct 12^{th-}, Porta Pott<u>iesy's</u> will be taken out. First year we have kept them until Columbus Day weekend. Will decide if we need the extra month use of toilets after <u>L</u>labor <u>D</u>day <u>next year</u>. Not happy with vendor this year so Shawna will investigate a new porta potty vendor.

Tom – Beach and recreation area. Over budget this year due <u>to</u> no spring cleanup and erosion on the beach. Looking into leveling off the beach. Ledge packed the beach parking lot and road to the beach to help with the erosion. In addition, the berm was extended to help with water flow that causes the erosion. Early spring the shed will be painted. Tom will remove the tennis and volleyball nets. Al to give Tom information about local plowing.

Lou – Docks and Moorings. Purchase a new ice blower estimated \$500. Ice breakers are coming, and the money is coming out of the main fund.

Ashley – <u>Discussed repairs of paved road areas</u>. Roads Fixing would be done in two phases.

- <u>1-Phase 1 will removeing pavement fromor</u> the corner <u>at O'Connor's house</u> to entrance of beach approx. Donna is willing to pay <u>one-half of cost for Pphase 1.</u> Need to discuss
- 2-Phase 2 will remove pavement from Woodrin to the main road. Will need to approach the family that lives on the corner to contribute towards costshelp pay for.

Quote for 15K for ledge pack and grinding up <u>existingalready</u> pavement would need to be done <u>before</u> <u>any new pavementwe pave</u>. Will <u>cost approximately be</u> \$45K. Brian and Blaire gave the estimate. Concern with the <u>lower section first half</u> of Woodrin Road due <u>to</u> all the water coming off it. Donna is not interested in <u>contributing towards</u> paving the whole section but would for the small portion.

Total West Point estimated cost will be \$7,500.0075,000 to put down ledge pack and no paving. -Iif we pave then it would be an additional \$15,000.

Ashley will talk to Donna about splitting the cost. Lou to find out if the house on corner will be willing to help with the cost.

Association has funds to cover the costs for the 1st pPhase 1; Pphase 2 is contingent on Phase 1 getting done.

Increase road budget to \$7,500.0075K.

Jon – Signs and Mailboxes

Signs - Three names need to be put on signs Ellis, Johnsons, Akins will be done in the Spring
