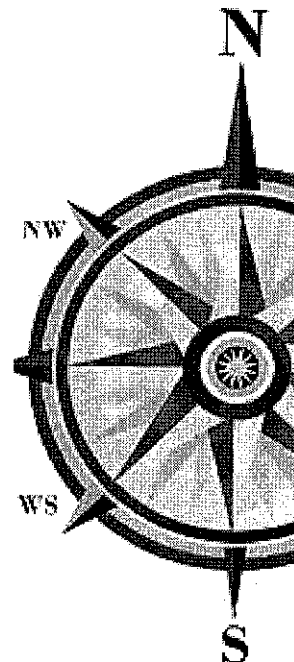

SAFE SNOWMOBILE & GOLF CART OPERATION

During the past few years, The West Point of Long Island Association has experienced increased usage of snowmobiles and golf carts within the community.

Although these vehicles are not prohibited, the Board of Directors feel it is necessary to communicate our thoughts with regard to the safe use of these vehicles. We all recognize the need for any powered vehicle to be operated in a safe, cautious and courteous manner on Association property.

In order to prevent any unfortunate accidents, the owners of these vehicles have the ultimate responsibility of ensuring supervised, proper, safe and orderly utilization. This includes the usage of such vehicles by adults and children alike.

Passengers should be limited to the number of seats designed for the vehicle being used. Any operation with persons standing on or running along side attempting to get on board of the vehicle is not considered safe operation.

From time to time two or more vehicles could be traveling in the same direction, the act of speeding up or racing one or more vehicles is very dangerous and should not be attempted.

Caution and slow operation should be the norm when approaching any person or persons walking along the road. The vehicle should slow (if not stop entirely) when confronted with a car or truck. In general, the same caution and discretion should be used as when driving on public roads.

The Board of Directors is not opposed to these types of vehicles in any manner. We simply hope for safe and accident-free operation within our community.
